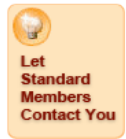

Samurai swords!)... my uninformed impression of the fine art scene is that it's decidedly *creepy*, that goober/mental grantsmanship and sucking up and gladhanding and embalming sharks is "art"... inflicting suffering on innocent pedestrians (Tilted Arc) is "art"... ogothavemercy, I think of sending you a photo of the dreadful Public Art appended to a bridge which is one of the Gateways to Ithaca. The guy clearly has a calling... as an apprentice welder. Art? Nahhhhtttttt sooooo much!

Yeah, so far apart! There is no "out" TS community here in Ithaca... just me, and some indeterminate-but-substantial number of stealthy types.

Heinlein's great, but kinda varies in quality; *Job*, though, is fantastic, one of the best books I've ever read!

Bear is kinda sorta the greatest modern heir to the hard SF tradition. I waay prefer him to Stephenson, whom I find 1) pretentious and 2) sciency rather than genuine SF. Bear writes some very speculative stuff, but it's all very well thought out, plausible, and coherent... when I read that "The Diamond Age" just got MORE incoherent towards the end, I felt justified in giving up halfway! ("Snow Crash" was a fun book... but makes *no sense at all* scientifically.)

I think Gibson is a *genius*... I came to him late, but eventually read the whole series of books stemming from Neuromancer, and I've wound up re-reading them. Repeatedly! "Idoru", e.g., it's fascinating stuff... and so well written!


