This guide explains the required operations the first time the camera is used, how to download images to a computer, as well as connecting to a printer for direct printing. For more information about handling precautions and detailed instructions, please refer to the manuals listed above.

Please refer to the *Troubleshooting* section of the *Software Starter Guide* if you have trouble installing the software or downloading images.

Do not connect the camera to the computer before the software is installed.

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Step 1 Preparing the Camera

1. Install the battery pack. Slide the battery cover in the direction the arrows to open it. Press the battery lock while inserting the battery pack all the way in and close the battery cover.



2. Charge the battery pack.

Connect the Compact Power Adapter to the camera as shown on the illustration. The indicator beside the viewfinder will blink orange while the battery pack is charging and will light steady once charging is complete.

- It takes approximately 80 minutes to charge the battery pack.
- Once charging is complete, disconnect the compact power adapter from the camera.

3. Install the CF card.

Slide the CF card slot cover in the direction of the arrow and lift it open. Insert the CF card with its label facing up until the CF card eject button fully extends and close the CF card slot cover. To Power Outlet



Step 2 Shooting

1. Open the LCD monitor, turn the mode lever to **(**shooting) while pressing the release button and turn the mode dial to ().

The Power/Mode indicator lights orange.

2. Set the date and time. (first time the camera is powered on)

Use the \blacktriangleleft or \triangleright arrow on the omni selector to select the items you wish to set, and use the \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown arrow on the omni selector to change the value. To put the settings into effect, press the **SET** button.

3. Focus.

Point the camera in the direction of the subject you wish to shoot and press the shutter button halfway. The camera beeps twice when the subject is in focus.

4. Shoot.

Press the shutter button fully. The shutter sound will sound once when the shot has been taken. The recorded image is displayed on the LCD monitor for approximately 2 seconds.

Turn off the power.

Press the **OFF** button. Even if you do not press the **OFF** button, the power will automatically shut down 3 minutes after the last control is accessed.

Step 3 Reviewing an Image

- **1.** Turn the mode lever to ▶ while pressing the release button. The power/mode indicator lights green. The last recorded image appears in the LCD monitor.
- **2.** View the images.

Use the \blacktriangleleft or \blacktriangleright arrow on the omni selector to display the image you wish to see.

To Delete an Unwanted Image

2. When the confirmation screen appears, check that [Erase] is selected and press the **SET** button.

Select [Cancel] using the \blacktriangleleft or \blacktriangleright arrow on the omni selector to cancel without erasing.

Printing with a Direct Print Compatible Printer (CP Series)

It is easy to print out crisp prints of the images you shoot by connecting your camera directly to a separately sold, direct print compatible printer (CP series) with a cable. For details, please see the user guide for the printer.

You can also print with a separately sold, direct print compatible Bubble Jet printer. For details, please see the user quide included with the Bubble Jet printer.

1. Load the ink cassette and the paper cassette into the printer.



2, Connect the power cord to the printer. With the printers that do not have an ON/OFF button, the printer's power turns on automatically.

3. Connect the camera to the printer and press the printer's ON/OFF button to turn on the power.
