databeast, Inc. agrees to provide consulting services and software as specified below, incorporating by reference Mann Library's product requirements as documented by William Garrison 8/28/96 in the First Draft of the "Saunders Contract Specs".

This work includes:

- 1a: Investigate Kerberos authentication alternatives, including use of CIT's FrontCar Macintosh client (under development with no current delivery date available) and development of alternatives.  
Testing and analysis to be completed by October 1, 1996.

100 hours maximum.

- 1b: If required, develop an alternative to FrontCar as specified.  
This will be delivered in beta form on or before November 1, 1996.

200 hours maximum.

- 2: Develop the Campus QI Database Query Utility as specified.  
This will be delivered in beta form on or before November 1, 1996, unless the FrontCar alternative is required, in which case it will be delivered in beta form on or before December 1, 1996.

200 hours maximum.

The final source and binary versions of these products will be delivered on or before January 1, 1996, and will be wholly and completely the property of Cornell University.

databeast, Inc. will bill Mann Library \$27/hour against a standing PO for the number of hours worked as incurred on each component of the project (with a maximum of 500 hours, for a maximum total of \$13,500).

**After talking some more with Tom Weyer, we've decided that waiting for CIT to complete development on their FrontCar plug-in puts us in too precarious a position. Tom left Cornell yesterday to work for Apple. Someone else is going to take over the development of their FrontCar plug-in (it might be Pete Bosanko), but Tom wasn't sure exactly when, or when we would get a copy of their beta.**

So, we'd like you to postpone development of the QI lookup application and start working on our own version of FrontCar, which we'll call "Agent Kerberos". Instead of a WebStar plugin, we'd like you to develop Agent Kerberos as a scriptable application, using the AppleScript dictionary from the original FrontCar applet as the AppleEvent interface. **Agent Kerberos should provide the same functionality as this FrontCar applet, which is basically to contact the user's SideCar server to request an authenticated Kerberos ticket, verify that the ticket's authenticity, and then return their Network ID as a string or return an error message.**

On our E-Reserves web server, I've put copies of the FrontCar applet distribution, and source code for CIT's Mac Kerberos versions 1.5 and 1.6.2 and information about the FrontCar AppleScript interface. Please take a look. The Kerberos stuff can be found at the CIT ftp server, but the FrontCar stuff is not publically available.
