Kevin "Bonze Blake" Saunders is a 46-year-old divorced white male with a history of Narcissistic Personality Disorder and psychosis. He was delusional two weeks ago with a "febrile illness"; involuntarily admitted, received Haldol, refused Zyprexa. Currently with pressured speech. Sleeping seven hours nightly. Chronic gender identity traits. Also conspiratorial delusions, self-medicating with cannabis.

He denies presence of mental illness, but states he's been weird since the age of nine. Two inpatient stays; last admittance two weeks ago. Client was on Prozac and Vistaril when he became paranoid and delusional; dressed as a female and set his girlfriend's trailer on fire five years ago. No suicide attempts nor history of ideation. He has been court-mandated to treatment, but is noncompliant with the mandate.

PHYSICAL/SEXUAL ABUSE OR NEGLECT: States he was the victim of a date rape by a male, but has tested negative for HIV and did not file charges. Reports no other abuse.

PAST PSYCHIATRIC MEDICATIONS: Trazadone -- priapism, hallucinations, paraesthesia Prozac -- impaired sexual function.

DRUG & ALCOHOL ABUSE: Caffeine - four cups per day, THC - 1/4 joint daily --. very minimized; tobacco - 1/2 package per day; alcohol, two beers "occasionally." HIV tested negative. Client appears to be highly minimizing drug use. Has had DWAI conviction.

Client had 18 months of drug and alcohol therapy. Client has no reported periods of sobriety.

Client does not require further evaluation because he is unwilling to notice a problem and would therefore neither comply nor benefit.

PAST MEDICAL HISTORY: Myoplasma pneumonia at age 17, strep throat at age 22.

Allergies - Environmental; has received desensitization injections.

He believes his fever recently caused psychosis.

ALLERGIES: Trazadone - hallucinations, diarrhea to ampicillin.

CURRENT MEDICATIONS: None

His primary care provider is Doctor Robert Breiman - Family Medicine Associates.
