PROCEDURE: Colonoscopy.

INDICATION: Screening.

REFERRING PHYSICIAN: Dr. Breiman.

MEDICATIONS GIVEN: 25 mg IV Demerol, 5 mg IV Versed.

PROCEDURE: After the colonoscopy procedure, including the risks, benefits and alternatives, not limited to perforation, surgery, and/or death were explained to Mr. Saunders, written consent was then obtained. IV medication was given and a rectal exam was performed. This was unremarkable. An Olympus colonoscope was then inserted into the patient's rectum and advanced very carefully through the entirety of the colon and into the cecal base. Careful and thorough inspection within the cecal base did not reveal any abnormalities. Quality of the preparation was good. The scope was then withdrawn through the remainder of the colon. At 40 cm from the anal verge was an 8 mm polyp. It was removed using a snare cautery polypectomy. Adequate hemostasis was achieved. In the rectum, a retroflexion maneuver was performed. This was unremarkable. The scope was withdrawn from the patient. He tolerated the procedure well and was returned to the recovery room in stable condition.

IMPRESSION:

- 1. Complete colonoscopy into the cecum with snare cautery polypectomy.
- 2. Single colon polyp, status post snare cautery polypectomy.
- 3. I will follow-up on the biopsy of this polyp. He should have a repeat colonoscopy in 5 years from now.
