The patient did accept the Invega Sustenna loading dose yesterday afternoon without incident and she now reports "It wasn't that bad." She states she's OK receiving the booster dose on Friday prior to discharge and is appropriately future-oriented in terms of making plans to go to DSS for emergency supports and getting her utilities turned back on in her home. The patient states that she is willing and agreeable with following up at TCMHC, although she states clearly that she doesn't feel the antipsychotic medication is necessary. "I'm OK just seeing a therapist and getting some support that way." The patient confirms that she used the computer to check her online bank statement and that she has sufficient funds to subsist on for the indefinite future.

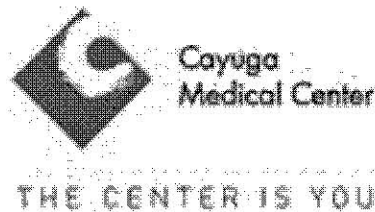
