She continues to display delusional beliefs, insisting for example that the police officer who apprehended her was an assailant in disguise. She insists that she is a victim of persecution from unknown others in the community. She has been refusing all medical and psychiatric medications here on the 4th floor. She denies SI or HI but is glaring at me angrily.

Clinical Impression:

62 y.o. single, white, male to female transgendered patient with a history of chronic psychotic and personality disorders, who is hospitalized on the Hospitalist service following an altercation with law enforcement at a local Denny's restaurant in which she was struck in the face, resulting in nasal fracture, elevated WBCs and elevated CPK. The patient was agitated and combative in the ER, requiring stat administration of IM lorazepam, ziprasidone and ketamine, as well as mechanical restraint for patient's and others' safety. Thereafter, she required surgery to reduce a separated left shoulder, which was performed on an emergent, involuntary basis after she refused it. On exam she is delusional, angry and hostile.
